

## Excursions from CAVTAT

All include travel from Cavtat and English speaking guide

### **MONTENEGRO (Full Day)**

Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat & Sun (08h15 – 17h30)

Cost: 390 KUN (approx. £48)

Spend the day visiting exotic Montenegro. Experience the beauty of Kotor Bay, high mountains rising from the sea, magnificent little towns along the way to medieval town Kotor. Guided city tour and free time before visiting picturesque Budva where have time for lunch (not included) or enjoy a swim at the sandy beach.

### **MONTENEGRO BAY (Full Day)**

Tuesday and Thursday (09h00 – 17h30)

Cost: 390 KUN (approx. £48)

Monte Negro Bay visits the Bay of Kotor and Perast, stopping in Kotor 2,5 hrs, than Perast for an hour or so, then a place called Verige for 30 min to an hour, finally returning to Croatia.

### **MOSTAR (Full Day)**

Upon Request (subject to min group numbers)

Cost: 390 KUN (approx..£48)

Mostar is a unique town in Bosnia and Herzegovina. As they say “Where East meets West”. There is the famous bridge from the 15<sup>th</sup> century, mosques, Ottoman architecture as well as the most amazing bazaars. Relax next to the river Neretva and enjoy delicious Ottoman cuisine. Mostar is one of the richest and the most enjoyable trips.

### **MOSTAR Waterfalls**

Every Day ( 07h05 – 17h30)

Cost: 450 KUN (approx.. £56)

One of the most fascinating natural wonders of the Herzegovina region, is definitely the crystal clear waters of Kravice. The waterfall created by the Trebizat river is a natural wonder. That is now under state protection. These waterfalls are amongst the largest in Herzegovina and definitely the most impressive. Mostar waterfalls goes to Dubrovnik first, short stop, and then goes to the most spectacular waterfalls (entry included) stops for an hour than to Mostar, where the city tour is for 30-40 min, and then over 2 hours free time

### **KORCULA (Full Day)**

Monday, Wednesday and Friday (07h05 – 17h30)

Cost: 430 KUN (approx.. £53)

Visit home town of the famous seaman and traveller Marco Polo. Breathtaking scenery along the coast on the way to Korcula. Short stop at the old town of Ston where the second longest man build wall is, as well as the oldest salt works in the world. Unique vineyards scattered along the peninsula

of Peliesac. Korcula is a stunning old stone city built by the famous stonemasons and it has been named a Jewel of Europe. On the way back you stop at the world famous winery for some wine-tasting and to meet the locals.

### **MEDUGORJE**

Schedule TBC (generally if sufficient interest) 07h05 – 17h30

Cost: 450 KUN (approx.. £56)

Medugorje is one of the most visited pilgrimage places in Europe. Since 1981 almost 40 million people have made the visit to this place, satisfying their spiritual needs. More than 30 years ago the Virgin Mary appeared, passing the message of peace to 6 youngsters from upon the hill.

### **ALAPHITE ISLANDS**

Every Day ( 10h00 – 17h30)

Cost: 320 KUN (approx.. £40)

Enjoy visiting three of the largest and the most beautiful islands of the Elafiti archipelago. Each of them is rich in baroque architecture of villas and castles. Don't miss relaxing while taking a walk through park islands and botanical gardens, take a dip in crystal water at one of the sandy beaches. The lunch is freshly grilled on board the ship. Local wines, soft drinks and water are included.

### **KONAVLE (Half day Tour)**

Every Day (10h00 – 15h30)

Cost: 400 KUN (approx..£50)

Explore the beauty and harmony of the Konavle valley, not far from Cavtat. See the picturesque valleys, historical sites, rivers and vineyards. Taste some of the oldest recipes of Mediterranean cuisine and authentic tasty wines at a local wine cellar.
