The Golden Circle.....the most popular day trip

The Golden Circle tour allows you to visit some of Iceland's most stunning sights, starting with the Geysir geothermal area where the Strokkur geyser shoots a column of water up to 30 metres (98 ft.) into the air every 4-8 minutes in a thrilling display of nature's forces. The visit continues with Gullfoss (Golden Falls) waterfall, created by the river Hvítá, which tumbles and plunges into a crevice some 32 m (105 ft.) deep.

Northern Lights.... see the Northern Lights in all their glory

The Northern Lights tour in Iceland takes you to see a spectacular natural phenomenon which happens during the winter months. The Northern Lights, also known as Aurora Borealis, are caused by the interaction of particles from the sun with the upper atmosphere near the North Pole. Northern Lights in Iceland are visible during the winter months, from September to April. Should you not see the Lights on the first evening, then you will be offered a 2nd chance the following night

Reykjavik Grand Excursion.... A detailed and comprehensive tour

This 3 hour guided tour gives you the highlights of Iceland's capital city in just three hours. We visit Hallgrímskirkja church; The Pearl with its fabulous viewing deck; Reykjavík City Hall, with its striking raised-relief map of Iceland (when available); and pass by Höfði House where Reagan and Gorbachev met in 1986 to begin the process of ending the Cold War. We also drive through the city centre, the harbour area, the University campus, past the Elliðaár river, and through Laugardalur valley

Whale Watching (lasts from 3 – 5 hours)

Whale watching tours are operated from the old harbour in Reykjavik. The whales most frequently seen on tours with Elding are the Minke whales, Humpback whales, Dolphins and Porpoises other species are sometimes spotted. We offer special suits on board for your comfort and warmth, but we advise you to wear your warmest clothes including hats, scarves, gloves etc. as it can get very cold, even on the warmest days.

Northern Lights and Hot Bath

Nothing compares to revitalising body and soul than by bathing in the geothermal baths at Laugarvatn Fontana.

We drive through the beautiful UNESCO site Pingvellir National Park on our way to Laugarvatn Fontana, you will have the option to choose if you would like to pay on the spot or not for either the local style dinner buffet or soup & bread.

Fontana has three steam rooms built over a natural hot spring and a traditional sauna along with four different hot pools. Those more adventurous, can take a dip in Laugarvatn lake (when available) and cool

down between the steam baths and sauna.

The steam temperatures range between 40°C and 50°C (104°F and 122°F), depending on the temperature The three connected outdoor mineral baths vary in depth, size and temperature. It is perfect to relax and socialise. From the hot tub, you can see a panoramic view of the countryside around Fontana and the northern lights if you are lucky and they show up early.

En route back to Reykjavík, we go on a northern lights hunt but since they're a natural phenomenon, sightings are not guaranteed.
