Description Tours in the Itinerary

BUENOS AIRES

HD DAY PANORAMIC CITY TOUR - Duration - 4 Hours INCLUDED



You will visit Plaza de Mayo (May): historical, political and foundational epicenter. Metropolitan Cathedral, Casa Rosada Government House, the Cabildo House and the Buenos Aires City Hall. This journey continues southwards, walking along old-stoned streets of San Telmo: “Tango” neighborhood. Following the same direction we will arrive in La Boca neighborhood. There we find Boca Juniors Football Stadium, which is the maximum example of Argentina’s Passion Football. We will visit Caminito: the most touristy place of the area. Bordering the Riachuelo, our tour continues northwards, visiting the old port we can notice how the physiognomy of the city changes.

Puerto Madero: panoramic view. In Retiro / San Martín Square, we connect with Libertador Ave. and we enter the north of Buenos Aires City. We will visit Palermo, which is a residential neighborhood with parks and elegant buildings. San Martiniano Institute, embassies, museums and significant monuments. Lastly we arrive at the area known as Bosques de Palermo (Palermo Woods): El Rosedal, Carta Magna and “Cuatro Regiones de Argentina” Monument and the Zoo. The tour ends in the Recoleta neighborhood, visiting the Cemetery where Eva Peron is buried.

FD SANTA SUSANA GAUCHOS RANCH - Duration 9 Hours – (OPTIONAL EXTRA \$115)

A typical gaucho ranch located in the district of Campana, just one hour from Buenos Aires.

Estancia's 1200 Hectares (2965 acres) are dedicated to agricultural activities and have been a popular tourist destination for the last 20 years.

During this full day tour you will have the most authentic experience by horse riding into the enchantment of the endless landscape of the remote Pampas.

Be amazed by the true tradition of the cowboys and their typical gaucho skills, enjoy a folkloric performance of typical gaucho dances, Tango and other traditional rhythms, and delight in a full gaucho barbecue that includes the best Argentine beef, salads, drinks and as much quality Argentinian wine.



HD TIGRE AND DELTA TOUR - Duration 5 Hours (OPTIONAL EXTRA PRICE TBC)

We will leave Buenos Aires City going to the north of Great Buenos Aires looking for the natural scenery of the Delta and its islands. The navigation has been designed to cover five of the main rivers of the first section of Parana delta islands.

Departing in comfortable boats of tourism you sail for an hour through the rivers Luján, Carapachay, Angostura, Espera and Sarmiento returning to the starting point, the River Station of Tigre.

We recommend viewing some characteristics places of Tigre and its Delta such as Buenos Aires Rowing Club, Canoteri Italiani, La Marina Regattas and many other clubs that make the history of rowing Argentinian.

During the tour you will see the Parque de la Costa, the Casino Trilenium, the Deliberative Council and the Tigre Cultural Center, better known as Tigre Hotel, located at Victoria Drive.

Navigating small rivers and internal streams will enjoy one of the most wonderful places and favorites of many Argentine families, discovering houses, schools and churches through the which will be able to recreate the unique island life

We will also see elegant residences located in the residential neighborhoods of the northern suburbs. We will visit the San Isidro neighborhood and its Cathedral. On the way back to Buenos Aires City, we will pass next to the Presidential Residence (Quinta de Olivos), where all the Argentinian Presidents live during their Presidencies



DINNER & TANGO SHOW AT LA VENTANA - Duration 4 Hours (OPTIONAL EXTRA \$108)

La Ventana Tango refers to the beginnings of the city of Buenos Aires and its old “conventillos” that forged the popular culture of our country.



Our Tango House is located in San Telmo, the historical neighborhood of the city, the cradle of tango by excellence continues with this tradition offering to those who visit us a Tango and Folklore Show accompanied by a traditional menu and Argentine wines, making your experience an unique souvenir.

EL CALAFATE

NATIVO EXPERIENCE CAVE TOUR (DINNER - Duration 3 Hours) (OPTIONAL EXTRA \$80)

Half day tour in which you will travel in 4x4 Land Rover vehicles along the coast of Lake Argentino, being an ideal activity for the arrival or departure day in El Calafate. The excursion offers an anthropological and historical approach to the passage of man in these lands, rediscovering the experiences of the first expeditions ventured into the unknown by the Santa Cruz River and Lake Argentino.

The tour focuses on the history of the first expeditionary contacts with the Tehuelches (native Indians of the area), crossing cliffs and marveling at views of Lake Argentino and the Andes Mountains.

After being picked up at your hotel in El Calafate, the first stop is at the lakeshore where flora and fauna are interpreted and you will also be given an explanation about glaciology and geology.

The second stop will be at the cliffs facing the lake from where you will have magnificent views of the environment.

Finally, on the third stop, you will visit the archaeological site. Here, you will see rupestre art in cave paintings next to shore of the lake, where thousands of years ago the Tehuelche culture left its mark on the rock and today we can interpret it. It is just there, inside the cave, where you will lunch or dine, enjoying a unique experience in a totally natural environment that will transport you to those remote years of the early explorers. After finishing the tour and meal, you return to El Calafate



FD PERITO MORENO GLACIER TOUR - Duration 8 Hours INCLUDED

Departure by route No. 11, bordering Argentino Lake. From El Calafate to the Perito Moreno Glacier, there is a distance of 80 km, along a paved road in its entirety.

From the beginning, the trip holds pleasant surprises. Leaving the Town, to the right we can observe the Argentino Lake with its Redonda Bay. In it you can see an important variety of birds, highlighting the necked swan black, flamingo, steam duck, coot, kauquen.

The yellow color of the field stands out, this is It owes its pastures called coirón, and among them stands out, the white and petiso coirón.



In the first 40 km the Patagonian steppe is crossed, passing later to the entrance of the National Park to observe the arboreal vegetation belonging mostly to the family "nothofagus" (nires, sour cherries, Lengas) and one or another canelo, and flowers of various colors, among them the "notros" stands out for its intense red color corresponding to the Andean Forest Patagonian.

Arrival at "the curve of sighs" called in this way because it is the first point from where we have a panoramic view of the Perito Moreno Glacier.

Brief stop to take pictures and continue to Puerto Bajo las Sombras. Then we go to the Footbridges where we will have a service sector for visitors and a system of balconies and walkways that allow walks through different tours and access to different really incredible views of the Glacier and its

proximity. After some free time for walks and lunch (optional), the return to El Calafate begins.

ALL GLACIERS NAVIGATION TOUR - Duration 9 Hours INCLUDED

Transfer to Puerto Punta Bandera (47 kilometers from El Calafate) and boarding for departure at 9:00 am after the captain reports on the safety and seaworthiness. Once on board, you will sail through the North Arm of Lake Argentino until the Upsala Channel, where you will find a spectacular Ice Barrier. From there, you will have a panoramic view of the Upsala Glacier. Then you will sail Spegazzini Canal, where you will see the Seco Glacier to reach the front of the highest Spegazzini Glacier National Park. We will prepare to disembark at the Spegazzini Base, to begin our visit of this area by walking along a forest path to reach the Spegazzini Refuge.



This accessible 300-meter path will lead us to stop at different stations and viewpoints that cover the entire Los Glaciares Bay. We can have lunch at the shelter (not included), visit the store or enjoy the beautiful landscape. Those who like trekking can follow the path to the mountain. This is a route of Medium difficulty trek that crosses a tree-lined path, full of natural views and incredible views, which ends at the landing point. Return to El Calafate. Accommodation.

IGUAZU FALLS

FD IGUAZU FALLS ARGENTINE SIDE TOUR - Duration 8 Hours INCLUDED

Sightseeing one of the seven new natural wonders of the world and the breathtaking panoramic



views of the Iguazu waterfalls. The tour will start visiting the beautiful Argentinian National Park to experience each distinctive and mind blowing Argentinian tour circuit which offers exceptional views of Iguazu falls. Discover the enchanting jungle covered walkways of the upper circuits to see the magnificent panoramic views of the smaller falls and the Iguazu upper delta.

Finally we will visit The Devil's Throat, Garganta del Diablo by train for an indescribable mix of beauty, energy, sounds and views. National park entrance fee included. Return to the Hotel and overnight.

GREAT ADVENTURE NAVIGATION TOUR - Duration 2 Hours (OPTIONAL EXTRA \$85)

Departing from the Operative Center at the Visitors' Center, we shall enter the jungle by the Yacaratiá trail in trucks specially designed for this environment. Bilingual guides (Spanish and English) will introduce the place's natural and cultural resources.

This 5 kms long stretch ends at Puerto Macuco. At its dock, visitors shall board on the boats that shall be sailing in the Lower Iguazu River for as long as 6 kms, heading towards the waterfalls area, enjoying plentiful rapids.

Upon reaching the Tres Mosqueteros Fall, visitors shall be able to see the falls of both the Argentine and Brazilian sides crowned by the view of the Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat). Afterwards, the most exciting point comes when facing the incomparable San Martín waterfall, the second in dimension and the hugest any boat may face. After that we'll navigate 6km down river until Puerto Macuco from where, after walking up hill 150 mts we'll ride the trucks 6Km back to our Operative Center



IGUAZU FALLS BRAZILIAN SIDE TOUR - Duration 5 Hours INCLUDED

Over there you will visit The Devil's Throat (also known as "Garganta del Diablo") is best seen from the Brazilian side.



Here fourteen falls drop 350 feet with such force that a 100 foot tall cloud of mist stays permanently suspended overhead. Watch for the rainbow! For a close up view, walk through the subtropical forest of Iguazu National Park to the base of Salto Floriano and take the elevator to the top of the falls, or walk out over the falls at Salto Union.

SAO PAULO

F1 GRAND PRIX OF BRAZIL - (3 Days, Qualifying - Grand Prix) INCLUDED

The Brazilian Grand Prix is a speed motor racing race held in Brazil since 1972, which has been valid for the Formula 1 World Championship since 1973. It is currently held at the Autodromo Carlos Pace in Interlagos Sao Paulo. Previously it also took place at the Nelson Piquet International Racetrack in Jacarepaguá, Río de Janeiro.

Traditionally the Brazilian Grand Prix was held in the fall, opening the season or within the first three rounds of the Championship. In 2004 it was played at the end of the season due to some improvement works at the Interlagos facilities, however due to the increased crowd success of being held in the spring, it has continued to be run towards the end of the season ever since, often as the closing race. For this reason, it has been the venue for the definition of the champion frequently in recent years.

RÍO DE JANEIRO:

FD CORCOVADO & SUGAR LOAF TOUR - Duration 8 Hours INCLUDED

We start the tour visiting Sao Bento Monastery, the Praça XV (square), the Travessa do Mercado, the Paseo Imperial, the Banco do Brasil, the Casa França-Brasil, the Ouvidor Street and the Goncalves Dias Street, the traditional Colombo Coffee Shop, the Carioca Square and the Metropolitan Cathedral.



Then around Rodrigo de Freitas lagoon; we cross the tunnel Rebouças to reach the traditional residential area of Cosme Velho and the train station of Corcovado. We board the train that climbs up to the base of the statue of the Christ Redeemer, at the top of the mountain, passing through the lush forest of Tijuca, one of the largest green

areas of forest preservation in the world.

After lunch (**not included**) we continue the sightseeing tour of Rio de Janeiro passing through the beaches of Leblon, Ipanema and Copacabana. Arrival at Morro da Urca, and take a cable car to ascend the second mountain - Pan de Azucar (Sugar Loaf). It is from these majestic view points that it is



easy to see how the early explorers believed that they had sailed into the mouth of a great river when they named Rio de Janeiro – which means River of January, as the city was discovered on the 1 st of January 1502. They had mistaken Guanabara Bay for the mouth of a great river. The most famous landmark of Guanabara Bay, this solid granite and quartz prominence rises 396m high above the sea and derived its name from the mountain's shape – which resembles conical clay molds used earlier to refine sugar
